  - a. Safety Director
    - i. Headcheck Concussion Application
      - 1. Tanner Highlen and Josh Bowden joined us from Headcheck via Zoom Call.
      - 2. Can be used to log any injury throughout the season and go through checklists. Would be visible to anyone when using the app. There are different levels of visibility for an athlete's status of injury and can toggle depending on their role (coach, board, parent, etc).
      - 3. Has a spot to check for Red Flags, connects to a map that shows the nearest medical facility
      - 4. Customizable to your organization
      - 5. Includes digital liability forms, videos, information, etc
      - 6. \$15/athlete/year for cost; can do a pilot run with 1 team to try it out
      - 7. Parent version of the app to see their child's stats and associated incident reports and see information to help with recovery. Parents would have access to see the steps for Return to Play and protocol.
      - 8. Data is kept in Canada.
      - 9. Can upload a doctor's note via uploaded picture to assist with return to play and gain clearance.

- 10. Store data for every year and keep it archived for 7 years; can be cross shared between different leagues – stays with the athlete regardless of what league they're in
- 11. There are consent forms and at the discretion of the organization.
